
The Season of Lent

It also prepares the faithful for Easter as they recall their Baptism and do penance in preparation for the greatest Feast of the year.

Lent recalls or prepares for Baptism, and emphasizes a spirit of penance. Through the forty days of closer attention to God's Word and for more fervent prayer, believers are prepared to celebrate the Pascal Mystery.
